What will we learn in 5th grade math class?

Grading

I will use a variety of grades during each marking period. Each unit of assessment will be based on <u>total points</u>, varying from one assessment to the next. You can access your child's grades on MMS, which will be updated in a timely manner.

Assessments:

- Homework completion: Students will receive 2 points for each completed homework assignment.
- Quizzes: Will be used to prepare students for the Topic Tests. Points will vary.
- **Topic Tests:** Topic tests will cover information that was learned in each topic. We will have anywhere from 2-3 Topic Tests per marking period. Points will vary but will be worth more than the quizzes.
- Classwork: May be used periodically at my discretion throughout the marking period. Points will vary.
- **Projects:** We will have math projects throughout this school year that will be completed mostly in class. Points will vary.

Homework Policy

Students are required to complete all homework assignments. As stated above, they will be graded for homework completion. If a student does not understand an assignment, they will still be expected to TRY it. I will answer any questions or concerns the following day in class. Any assignment that is not complete will receive a 0 for that day.
