

# Does your child need a COVID-19 test? Get answers quickly.

As a student attending in-person classes at this school, your child has access to expedited medical evaluations and priority processing of COVID-19 testing through Lehigh Valley Health Network (LVHN). That means you'll receive your test results in 48 hours.\* LVHN processes COVID-19 tests at HNL Lab Medicine allowing you to get answers quickly.

## COVID-19 symptoms

To receive an expedited medical evaluation and priority testing, your child must have at least one of the following symptoms:

- Fever (temperature  $\geq 100.4$ )
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or trouble breathing (more trouble than usual if a child has a chronic respiratory condition)
- Congestion or runny nose
- Chills or repeated shaking with chills
- Fatigue
- Unexplained muscle or body aches
- Headache (beyond prior history of headaches)
- Sore throat
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- New loss of taste or smell


## Next steps

If you think your child may have COVID-19, contact his or her primary care provider or obtain an LVHN screening for the coronavirus online or over the phone.\*\*

### COVID-19 screening options:

- Complete an E-Visit (detailed questionnaire submitted to a provider) by going to [MyLVHN.org](https://MyLVHN.org) or using the MyLVHN app.
- Call the MyLVHN Nurse Information line at 888-402-LVHN.
- Complete an LVHN Video Visit on the MyLVHN app.

During the screening a health professional will let you know if your child should receive COVID-19 testing. Testing for symptomatic patients is offered at LVHN Assess and Test locations throughout the region. Find an Assess and Test close to you by visiting [LVHN.org/SchoolPartners](https://LVHN.org/SchoolPartners).

 **TIP** If you don't see your child's name on your own MyLVHN account, you'll need to request proxy access from your child's provider or by calling 888-402-LVHN (5846). Proxy access lets you schedule appointments, check immunization records and set up LVHN Video Visits on their behalf.

## COVID-19 clearance testing

There may be times when your child does not feel sick but requires COVID-19 clearance. LVHN can help. Find clearance testing locations near you at [LVHN.org/SchoolPartners](https://LVHN.org/SchoolPartners).

## MyLVHN mobile app

LVHN makes it convenient to view your test results. After your child's COVID-19 test, there's no need to wait for a provider to call you. You can view your child's COVID-19 test results and quarantine instructions as soon as they are available on the MyLVHN patient portal.
